


# Remote Work Collaboration with DMS

Under 10 percent of employees cited COVID as the sole reason for working remotely, according to <a href="The Bureau of Labor Statistics">The Bureau of Labor Statistics</a>. However, according to <a href="Gallup">Gallup</a>, approximately 45 percent of full-time employees in the United States either work partially or fully remote. The Gallup report found that 67 percent of white-collar job employees reported working partially remote or fully remote. Gallup also found that jobs that require face-to-face interactions, such as healthcare and education, reported lower levels of working virtually part or full time.

Gallup also reported that "91 percent of workers in the U.S. working at least some of their hours remotely are hoping their ability to work at home persists after the pandemic." Gallup also found that "54 percent of employees who work remotely at least some of the time say they would ideally like to split their time between working at home and in the office -- a hybrid arrangement. A little over a third (37 percent) would like to work from home exclusively, while 9 percent want to return to the office full time." Employees are citing many perks to working remotely as their main push for work environment change.

Employees are finding new benefits of remote working, such as time saving due to lack of commuting. As gas prices continue to soar, reducing the amount of driving benefits employees' pockets. Working remotely also creates flexibility in employees' lives and allows them to balance personal and professional obligations easier. Employees responded to Gallup's survey saying they were experiencing improved productivity and wellbeing due to remote work. Approximately three in ten employees also stated that they were very likely to look for work elsewhere if their employers eliminated the option to work from home.
